Creation of a network cooperation between clusters linked to nautical and shipbuilding sectors through the mapping of activities (a. wood; b. mechanic; c. plastic-rubber; d. textile).</li> <li>2. Preparation and submission of a questionnaire sent to more than 1,000 subjects operating in the nautical sector: 42 clusters; 53 excellence centers; 327 enterprises).</li> <li>3. Organization of 3 B2B and B2C involved a total of 350 companies for a total of about 1020 meetings: Nautical Fair of Venice; Pula Boat Fair; ORC – World Sailing Championship of Ancona.</li> <li>4. Three Cluster Animation meetings finalized to the exchange of best practices involved 142 participants and 42 clusters: Padua (February 2012); Tirana (March 2012); Venice (November 2013).</li> <li>5.
